

**Sherburne United Church of Christ
Women's Fellowship Advanced Education Award**

April 12, 2011

This award is a financial assistance award, amount to be determined by vote of the Women's Fellowship on a yearly basis - based on the financial status of the organization.

The purpose of this award is to recognize and support a high school graduate (from a local high school) wishing to further her/his education. The candidate must have contributed to the service and congregation of the Sherburne United Church of Christ, her/his school, fellow students and the community/ies which our children reside in - while remaining a student in good standing in a local school system.

A winning student will be announced at Sherburne United Church of Christ's annual service honoring graduates.

To earn this award a graduating student should meet the following criteria:

1. Candidate must be a student in good standing in a local high school. (passing grades, good behavior record, etc.)
2. Such student must submit, in writing, to the Women's Fellowship of the Sherburne United Church of Christ, a short summary of service to Sherburne United Church of Christ and its congregation, service to the community, the school attended, and any organizations where she/he has been a member. This should also include a statement as to her/his intentions for further education.
3. This statement should be submitted in a timely manner to be reviewed by the UCC Women's Fellowship (committee to be determined yearly) prior to May 22, 2011. (This date may vary, according to yearly committee decision.)
